Minutes:

The Minutes from the December meeting were sent prior. Bob made a motion to approve the minutes, Jerod seconded the motion.

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's report was read by John. There being the following balances:

Hall Improvements:

- Jerod spoke with Chris Lawrence, cabinets are ordered. There is a long lead time with anticipated Spring installation.

ARPA Funds:

- Kristen explained the requirements needed for reporting for ARPA funds. The qualifications are much more stringent than the CARES funds for reporting. Kristen spoke with Jennifer, auditor at the county, and she advised the county is hiring a consultant to manage the funds to make sure legal and State requirements are met. Kristen is going to ask the same consultant their fees and if they have the ability to take Rocksbury on as well. The fees would be covered as an administrative expense under the ARPA funding.

Permits:

No permits requested in January.

Sorteberg Drive:

Residents did call asking to get the road fixed as there were poor conditions. Rude was able to get the road fixed. Jerod mentioned we do need to keep this road in mind as it does have higher traffic and potentially a deteriorating culvert.

Townhall Rental:

- Jerod is already getting requests to rent the hall for this Spring/Summer. Asked if we should revisit wedding prices to make sure it is not too high. Would like to revisit comparable locations. Scott mentioned including rental prices on the annual meeting agenda.

Resident Concern:

Kristen received call from resident John Mattison regarding concerns. He mentioned the potential in having an annual newsletter to residents. Kristen shared with the Board. New websites and the ability to update and add minutes to the site will enable residents easier access to information.
