Minutes:

The Minutes from the April meeting were sent prior. Bob made a motion to approve the minutes, Jerod seconded the motion.

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's report was read by John. There being the following balances:

Neil and Sharon Bugge: Requesting to potentially have their son purchase land for a mobile home. Would need to rezone using a conditional use permit to move land of agricultural to residential. Kristen will mail Sharon an application. Property would be over four-acre requirement. There are no designations on the residential. Also need to contact Mike Flaggan for road needs. Would also need to talk to watershed.

Dan Kotaska: Dan originally filed for a license from the ATF. ATF agent needed letter that there are no restrictions sale on firearms. Could be from township or county. County approved the request and this was submitted to the ATF. Scott asked that Dan have Nathan Haase look at the approval from the county to ensure this would be ok for township requirements. Dan is switching to drop ship method which minimizes any traffic to home.

Nick Vettleson: Nick Vettleson reached out to Kristen asking if he will still be mowing at the Township this year. Kristen asked for updated rates and will follow up for insurance information. No response yet from Nick.

Oakland Park Road: Scott had received a phone call from a resident to potentially pave a partition of the south Oakland Park Road. Scott shared a previous quote received for Basswood court received with the resident. If residents would elect to do this, the township would pay for the road and the residents would then receive special assessments on their property. Residents could potentially be charged upfront for some of the cost. No decisions have been made, but this could potentially be continued.

Airport Hangar: Scott shared there will be improvements made to the Airport. There may be a requirement to inspect the building process. Rocksbury would be able to temporarily pass inspection rights to the City as the Township does not have an inspector.
